President Macri's Cambiemos (We can Change) Party's administration, is known to be:

- Center-Right Leaning, Proactive, Pragmatic,
- Market & Business friendly

**Promised:** 

- **Kick start a stalled economy**
- **Find the real state of the country's financial situation**
- **•** Fight corruption
- Find solution to weak growth, high inflation, poverty and to tackle the gaping fiscal deficit left by the former administration
- Remove capital controls / Restore the Central Bank's independence
- **•• Overhaul the country's Statistic Administrator (INDEC)**
- Increase legal security for foreign investors



## POLITICAL & ECONOMIC CONSIDERATIONS

#### **ECONOMIC ENVIRONMENT**

- <sup>CS</sup> Latin America's 3rd largest economy- 2015 GDP USD 537 bn, (World Bank 2016 April update).
- It has more equal income distribution than other Latin American countries and a broad middle class.
- 2005-2015 Argentina was a risky and difficult place to do business.
- OBC 2015, the currency controls were released and USD free floatation
- G Fast with economic reforms, with some positive results already showing.
- Over the last months reserves have grown 21.6% (ref: AR Central Bank)
- Inflation continues to be an issue, however it is decreasing and is predicted to continue decreasing in the following years



## POLITICAL & ECONOMIC CONSIDERATIONS

#### **2/ ECONOMIC ENVIRONMENT**

- Success tackling head on the debt with the so-called American 'Vulture funds' bringing Argentine back into the confidence of the international community.
- Recently, more than 600 foreign investors gave a vote of confidence with a record US 16.5 bn bond sale. Prat-Gay was ecstatic and stated that he could have issued and sold twice that or even more. Offered Capital was USD 62.5 bn
- Importation restrictions and taxes have been reduced or completely removed, as well as levies and taxes on exportations.
- <sup>CS</sup> The government will guarantee a full framework of legal security for foreign investors.
- It has been projected that Argentine will show a mid-term positive result from these reforms, with an increased productivity and a more robust economy. However, the next 12 months will most likely be characterised by stagflation and a 1% contraction in GDP.

## ASIAN MARKET OPPORTUNITIES FOR BOTH ARGENTINE AND NEW ZEALAND

- <sup>63</sup> NZ has trade agreements and partnerships in all key and secondary markets in East and South East Asia. Bilateral trade agreements have been signed (Such as the NZ-China Free trade agreement).
- <sup>CS</sup> The Asean Economic Community (AEC) has the 7<sup>th</sup> largest economy (and could be the 4<sup>th</sup> by 2050). NZ is dialogue partners of Asean Free Trade Area.
- **NZ** exports to China are second only to exports to Australia.
- MZ has high reputation and efficient distribution chain for very high qualified products.
- <sup>CS</sup> The Economic and Commercial concierge to the Chinese embassy in Argentine, Mr. Zhai Chengyu, recently said that Chinese investment in Argentina was USD 12 bn in last years.
- A Chinese Import/Export Bank as well as the Chinese Development Bank opened offices in Argentine recently. Chengyu stated that support of joint projects in the future is perfectly feasible.
- Argentine's exports to Asia in 2015 = USD 16.6 bn

### **ARGENTINE POTENTIAL**

#### **ARGENTINE AGRIBUSINESS POTENTIAL**

- Macri's first speech to the local farming community "We must stop being the breadbasket and become the supermarket" to the world.
- He spoke of a need for diversity and value added products. For this to happen successfully there would need to be an increased <u>investment in new</u> <u>technologies and in infrastructure and well as increased confidence from</u> <u>the farming community</u> that there will be enduring support from above.
- <sup>13</sup> The Government moved quickly to make reforms in the Agriculture sector, among others:

-Removed crop shipment quotas

-Removed or reduced export levies and taxes

-The liberalisation of the AR Peso against USD has also made Argentine more competitive.



### **ARGENTINE POTENTIAL cont.**

- Argentine has strong market presence with crops, dairy, beef and is making inroads into specialist markets, such as the wine industry.
- Is the second highest producer of Organic produced in the world and has potential to lead in this market.
- <sup>CS</sup> The economic and commercial concierge to the Chinese Embassy to Argentine, Zhai Chengyu, recently stated that all Argentine food products could have a market in China. (Ref.: La Nacion – 30/04/16)
- Argentine is currently the 5<sup>th</sup> source of agricultural produce for China. Last year they imported US \$5900 million, (a rise of 12.7% on the prior year). Principally exported were soy and soy oil, but with increases in the beef and wine industries, as well as other areas.
- G Further inroads would depend on price compatibility, promotion, distribution, produce quality and services.
- Argentine exports represent 0.2% of the total Chinese imports and are predicted to rise to 1% in the following five years.

NZ: High reputation + distribution chain + high quality products + need to grow AR: Low presence in A M+ large scale + high quality agriproducts + need to grow



### SUMMARY

- Argentine is building a new pathway for itself and is integrating back into the international marketplace.
- Change in Argentine has come with some social and political complications, but the economic future and the country's reputation are looking brighter than in a last decade.
- ✓ NZ business have interesting opportunities in AR.
- ✓ Asia is a massive market with an increasing demand.
- ✓ This period is a good time to develop cooperative relationships with a shared vision and a view to a mutually beneficial future.
- ✓ NZ could act as a HUB between LATAM and Asean Markets
